## Executive Protection Course – TCOLE #3105

The **Basic Dignitary Protection School** is an intensive, six-day program designed to prepare officers for work in executive protection assignments. This course provides foundational instruction in protective detail operations, team formations, firearms handling, counter-surveillance, protective driving, advance work, and practical scenario-based exercises. Over six days, students' will progress from classroom instruction and live-fire training to force-on-force scenarios and a full-scale dignitary protection exercise, testing their ability to plan and execute protective missions in realistic environments.

This course is demanding both mentally and physically. Students can expect long training days with minimal breaks, requiring sustained focus, discipline, and endurance. Instruction is conducted in a high-tempo environment designed to replicate real-world executive protection operations. Training will take place at multiple sites across the San Antonio area and surrounding locations. Upon successful completion, RDI will submit documentation for 60 hours of TCOLE credit. This course is **Law Enforcement Sensitive (LES)**. Credentials are required to register.
